Terms of Use

Please read these terms of use before using our Club Locker Service

The Scarborough Campus Student's Union owns and operates the use of Club lockers throughout the Fall and Winter semesters. These terms of usage will govern your access to, and the use of, its services provided your party co-operates with the following rules of operation, policies, and procedures without exception. For purposes of these terms, the "User" (i.e., the Club associated with the locker assigned), are to follow these rules or there will be retribution for a breach of agreement.

General Locker Usage and Prohibited Items

The SCSU provides club lockers to clubs for ease of access storage purposes. To acquire a club locker, a signing officer of the club must visit the SCSU office between its hours of operation with a \$20.00 cash deposit. The Club lockers can be found on the second floor of the Student Centre near the SL-232 Boardroom at the end of the hallway. The following items are prohibited from being stored in the lockers:

- Any type of firearm and weapons (brass knuckles, martial arts weapons, etc.)
- Toy/replica and imitation weapons
- Firearm parts
- Flares, fireworks, gas cannisters
- Any flammable object that can cause damages/harm
- Explosive substances and objects, as well as any device that can ignite (i.e., Lighters)
- Bows, Cross bows, and Arrows
- Chemicals such as mace, pepper spray, tear gas, etc.
- Saws, including power saws, cordless saws, and such
- Sexual toys or items

<u>Damages and Repairs</u>

If during the time of usage Student center caretakers and/or SCSU staff report visible damages of the locker in use, your club will be liable to compensate for the repairs and face the risk of being blacklisted from club services from the Scarborough Campus Student's Union. Please ensure that the space is always being taken care of.

Deadlines for Usage

Note that the SCSU Club lockers are only meant to be used during the Fall & Winter semesters. Summer semesters are excluded as that is the time lockers are serviced for the next term of usage. Lockers are to be issued out starting from the first day of each semester and throughout the semester (or if any other date is mentioned by the Internal Coordinator). The last day of use will be the last day of the Winter semester, which is determined by UTSC sometime in April. If your clubs' items remain in the locker after this date, they are liable to be removed by SCSU staff and caretakers and the SCSU is not responsible for the items once they have been discarded.

Collecting the Deposit

Once the term for using a club locker has passed, clubs are to pick-up their \$20.00 deposit from the SCSU office with the signing officer who signed off on the locker for use. Please make sure you have collected the deposit. Deposits that are not collected will be non-refundable after August 31st.
